Rules:

The rules and regulations governing the exhibits under the auspices of the National WIC Association (NWA) Conference are part of the agreement for space.

Agreement for Space:

This application for a virtual exhibit booth space and the receipt of full payment together constitute an agreement for the right to use the virtual space.
