Attention WA WIC Vendors,

We have been reaching out to our WIC vendors to identify any supply chain issues or inventory shortages of WIC approved formula and foods. While many larger chain stores have reported stocking issues due to increased customer demand, smaller stores are reporting challenges with order fulfillment from their wholesale distributors or distribution centers.

In an effort to improve availability of ALL WIC foods for program participants, and the general public, we are asking WIC vendors to impose purchase limits on high-demand WIC foods. In particular, this request is for WIC approved infant formula and dairy products, which continue to be in high-demand and impacted by scarcity across our state. While purchase limits present a hardship to those looking to stock up on items, this will help to ensure product availability for all during these extraordinary times.

While not always feasible, allowing WIC participants to purchase WIC foods without limits is the preferred approach and will help to ensure participant's access to these critical foods. If you have the ability to further support WIC customers by holding aside specific WIC products in high- demand, this would be beneficial to WIC participants during this time.
