#### **BREASTFEEDING IN WIC**

The United States WIC breastfeeding initiation rates increased by 10 percent between 2010 and 2020.

Among WIC infants who initiated breastfeeding in the U.S. in 2020, 22 percent continued breastfeeding at 6 months.



Fruit and Vegetable Benefit: Congress enhanced WIC's fruit and vegetable benefit to align with scientific recommendations. Current monthly benefit amounts are \$26 for children, \$47 for pregnant and postpartum participants, and \$52 for breastfeeding participants. In FY 2023, WIC provided an estimated \$1.9B in fruit and vegetable benefits to **5,105,466** participants in the United States.
